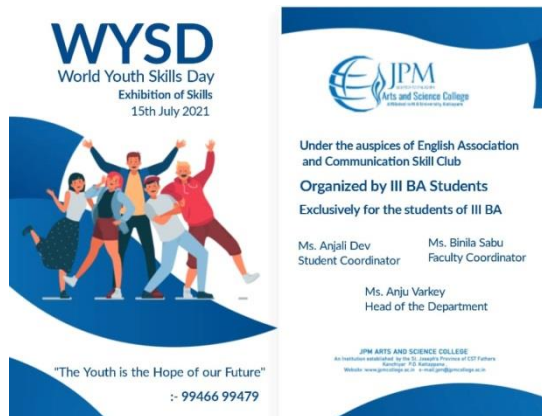
19th June 2021 - Vayana Dinam (Reading Day)

Department of Management studies commemorated Kargil Diwas under the auspices of the Management association and life skill club by conducting a pencil drawing competition which was open for the department students.

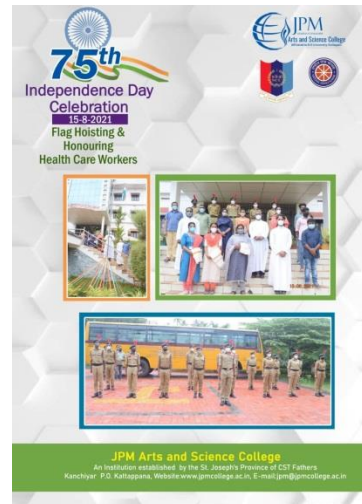
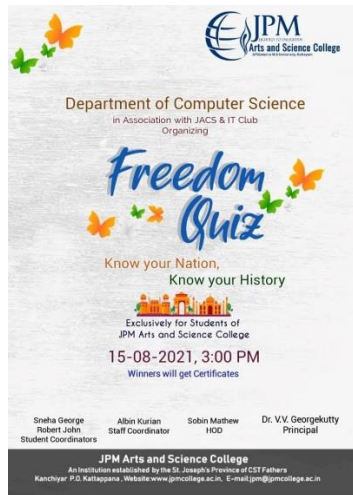


15th August 2021 - Independence Day

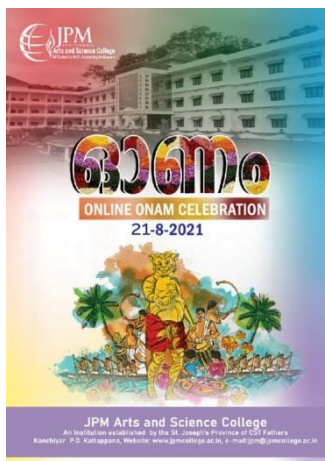


21st August 2021 - Onam Celebrations

Onam celebration commemorated online adhering to the covid protocol set by the authorities.

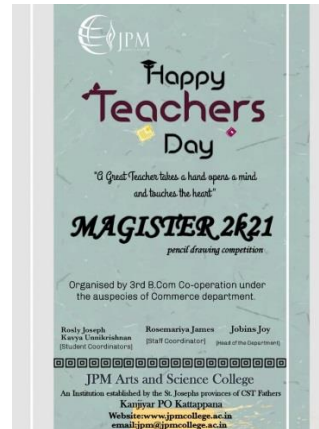
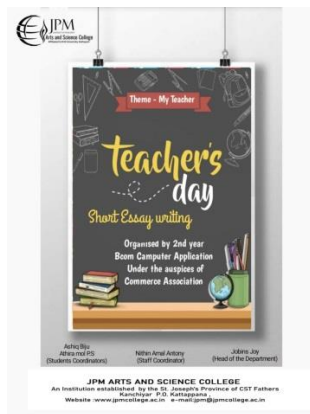

8th September 2021 - Literacy Day

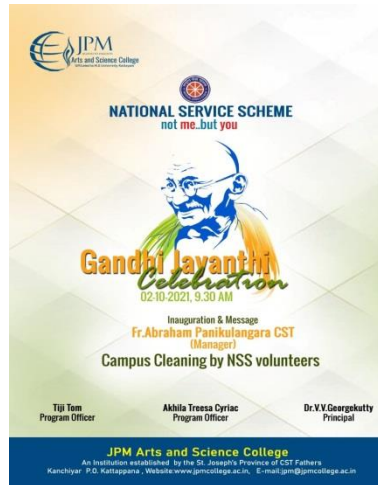

2nd October 2021 - Gandhi Jayanthi

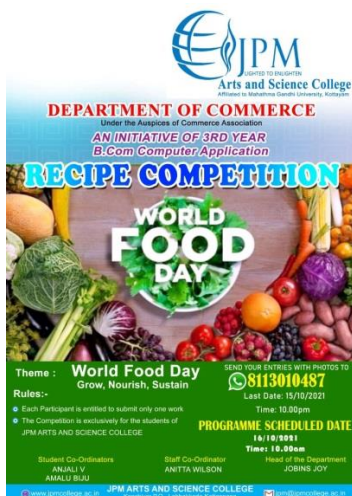

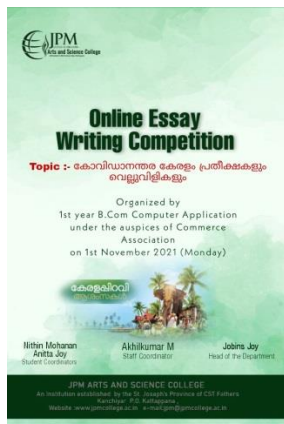
16TH October 2020 - World Food Day
