

WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY

The college is obliged to strictly follow the green protocol that is Reuse, Reduce and Recycle because the nature produces no waste only the man does. The objective is to minimize the waste production in the campus. A number of initiatives have been taken up to achieve this aim:

- The college acknowledges its environmental responsibilities and is obliged to contribute to the global development agenda

- Reusing waste items wherever feasible, either internally or in association with third parties or donating to others by considering these options before items are discarded.
- Recycling by sorting into waste categories which could be wisely done in the segregated waste bins to maintain the clean, green and beautiful surroundings of the college campus and finding recycling markets for removal.
- Risk consideration by constantly considering 'end-of-life' disposal (costs and environmental impact) when making purchasing decisions.
- The policy binds all the institutional activities ensuring green campus.
- Onsite treatment options such as composting, bio-manure, etc. should be used in the campus.
