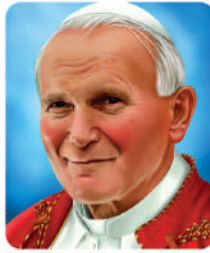

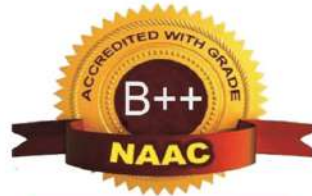

The short-term courses are, Certificate in Therapeutic Skills for Helping Professions (Counseling), Certificate Course in Advanced Social Research Methodology, Certificate Course in Social Perspective in Disaster Management. The short term/ certificate courses will surely add a value to their career.

For the wholistic development of the students, curriculum-based classroom teaching is supplemented with co-curricular activities. JPM conducts activities facilitating the development of various domains of mind and personality such as intellectual, emotional, social, moral, and aesthetic development. Creativity, enthusiasm, and energetic and positive thinking are some of the facets of personality development and the outcomes of extracurricular activities.

Debates and Discussion

As a student and also later in life every person gets into debates and discussions. These are important means to exchange ideas. Debates help to improve knowledge and reasoning skills. Debates and discussions at JPM help students acquire essential critical-thinking and presentation skills. They acquire better poise, speech delivery, and public speaking skills, improve listening, note-taking skills and increase self-confidence and enhance teamwork skills and collaboration.

Seminars and Webinars

Departments conduct various seminars and webinars to provide students with intensive training and better exposure to topics in the curriculum. Students are expected to participate regularly in college-level seminars, including giving presentations and participating in discussions. Attending a seminar has numerous benefits, including improving communication skills, gaining expert knowledge, networking with others and renewing motivation and confidence. A good number of national and international seminars, workshops and webinars have been organized under the auspices of various departments throughout the academic year.

Peer Teaching

Students learn a great deal by explaining their ideas to others and by participating in activities in which they can learn from their peers. They develop skills in organizing and planning learning activities, working collaboratively with others, giving and receiving feedback and evaluating their own learning. JPM promotes peer-assisted learning. Students are required to engage peer teaching sessions.

Remedial teaching and Mentoring

The objective of remedial teaching is to give additional help to pupils who, for one reason or another, have fallen behind the rest of the class. The purpose of remedial teaching involves individualized teaching of students who are experiencing difficulties

in specific subject areas. JPM has special scheme to ensure remedial teaching for slow learners. Each student is personally known to our teachers. Mentoring and tutorial system in JPM aims at addressing and study related problems of students and enabling them better resolve issues in life.

UGC NET JRF Exam Coaching

The National Eligibility Test (NET) is the test for determining the eligibility for the post of Assistant Professor and/or Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) award in Indian universities and colleges. Students in JPM are provided with specialized coaching for UGC-NET/JRF exam for better results. Along with the regular classes as well as apart from the class hours our experienced teachers prepare students to appear for NET exam.

Basics of Computing

It's important for every student to know fundamentals of computers. Knowledge about the fundamentals of computer science, internet, programming, web-pages, etc. help them to build career successfully. We ensure that our students are trained with the basics of computer and information technology along with the approved curriculum.

Placement Assistance

The Placement Cell plays a crucial role in locating job opportunities for Under Graduates and Post Graduates passing out from the college by keeping in touch with reputed firms and industrial establishments. The Placement Cell operates round the year to facilitate contacts between companies and graduates. Placement Cell gives students the opportunity to gain skills specific to their subject or industry of choice as well as the employability skills required for real-life work. It also increases their knowledge of an industry or sector, allowing them to make better informed decisions about future career

choices. JPM has a vibrant placement cell functioning under a placement officer. The Cell conducts various programmes with a view to molding students capable to meet the industry expectations. We conduct interviews / GDs / On-line tests and facilitate every student to define his/her career objective through career counselling. Last year we have succeeded in securing more than 100 placements in reputed firms.

Diplomas and Add Ons

Add-on courses or certificate courses help students learn additional subjects apart from their main course. Over the years, their importance has increased because of various reasons and JPM now offers add-on courses and certificate courses on different areas. The aim is to provide additional learner centric graded skill oriented technical training, with the primary objective of improving the employability skills of students.

Start Ups

Startups may be small companies but they can play a significant role in economic growth. They create more jobs which means more employment, and more employment means an improved economy. Not only that, startups can also contribute to economic dynamism by spurring innovation and injecting competition. We encourage students to be social entrepreneurs as change makers who apply business principles to social causes. Within a short span of time, we have a handful of successful startups established by our students.



Extracurricular activities provide a place for students to come together, discuss pertinent ideas and issues, and accomplish common goals. Within this community, where students feel comfortable with one another, learning and development are enhanced and student retention is positively impacted. A wide and diversified range of extracurricular activities are organized on the campus to meet diversified interests of the students.

The college has two units of National Service Scheme with 300 volunteers. It aims at training members in the spirit of service and promotes opportunities for the development of character and leadership qualities. Students are encouraged to take up membership and profit by the opportunities for service activities. NSS certificate holders get weightage marks for admission to higher courses and also get grace mark.

A unit of NCC started functioning in the college in 2020 with an intake of 35 cadets. The main purpose of the NCC is to provide military training to the students, inculcating in their minds the twin ideals of duty and discipline. NCC provides opportunities for developing one's physical and intellectual potential. Students who qualify to receive B and C certificates will find it easy to get commissioned posts in army/navy. Membership in the NCC entitles one to get weightage in admissions to college/university programmes. We have an Army wing of NCC in the campus.

The United Nations Ac-

ademic Impact (UNAI) is an initiative that aligns institutions of higher education with the United Nations in supporting and contributing to the realization of United Nations goals and mandates, including the promotion and protection of human rights, access to education, sustainability and conflict resolution. The college has a UNAI Aspire active chapter working in the campus.

Physical education is part of the general education programme. The college offers facilities to students who are keen on developing their potentials in sports and games and thereby promoting qualities of sportsmanship, team spirit and good physique. The college encourages all students who are interested in sports and games and it provides all facilities for them. Competitions have been held annually in various games and for tracks and field events.

The college has qualified counselors to provide counseling service to students in order to equip them address issues and challenges in life. Counseling support plays a crucial role in the holistic development of students.

The Tourism Club of JPM is formed under the auspices of the Department of Travel and Tourism with the intention of creating awareness among the youth about

Tourism Activities and there by promote and tourism and related activities. The Tourism Club of the college gets support and guidance from the District Tourism Promotion Council.

The computer labs of the college are well equipped with eighty-five high-end systems to cater to the needs of each and every student. There is a separate lab for the Post Graduate students and Add-On courses. Language lab and project lab are available for language studies and projects works. There is free internet connectivity and Wi-Fi with optical fiber facility.

The primary purpose of the library is to provide resources and services in a variety of media to meet the needs of students and teachers for education, information and personal development including recreation and leisure. JPM Library offers the resources and encourages the thinking process, creativity, inquisitiveness and makes the learning more fruitful. Our library provides more than fifteen thousand textbooks and many periodicals, research publications to students, teachers and researchers. Libraries are said to be the precious life blood of a nation. We subscribe a number of frontline national and international journals, magazines, bimonthlies, weeklies and newspapers as well. A new block of international standards for central library and information center has already began on the campus and is expected to be complete in this academic year.

JPM Post is a quarterly publication from the college. It is unique in its kind and had its first edition in the year 2012. It serves as a canvas to students to portray the latent creativities among them.
