The management, staff and students joined hands in helping the community during the pandemic Covid 19 by distributing groceries worth Rs25,000/-(Rupees Twenty five thousand only) on

9<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Twenty five bags of groceries worth Rs1000/- each were handed over to

the Tribal King H.H. Raman Raja Manan for distribution among the tribal families in the villages. Under the scheme a pond in the village was renovated and a pump set installed at a cost of Rs 125000/- (Rupees One lakh twenty five thousand only). The renovated pond and water supply system was inaugurated on 01<sup>st</sup> January, 2021 by the Kovilmala King H.H. Raman Raja Mannan.
