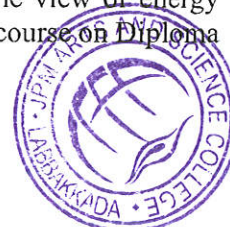
and T Students had scored a pass percentage of 98%, third B.Com Cooperation with 93%, third B.Com CA with 95% and final year M.Com with 65%.

A Training session has been initiated from 22nd February 2023 onwards for boosting up students for placements sessions which are being led by teachers and students in the evening from 3.10 pm to 5 pm. Walk in interview in association with Malayala Manorama and ESAF bank were conducted on 11th and 17th of March 2023.

23. Faculty of Religion

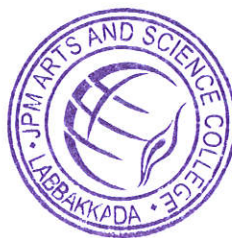
Value education classes were arranged for all the students and orientation and indication programmes were arranged in the beginning of the academic year. Counselling facilities are also provided for the students.

27. Extension Activities

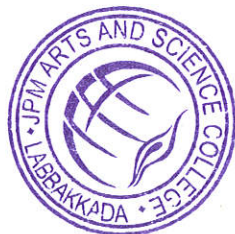
- “New India – Kovilmala Tribal Kingdom: An Integrating Mission of JPM” Eye Camp
